ion, skilled and unskilled, native and foreign worker. At the same time, ideas of unionism were introduced by American workers and Glace Bay miners. Workers at the steel plant participated in the international fight for the 9-hour day, and at one point 400 people were off the job. But they also saw examples of scabbing, of failures due to lack of solidarity. Although outside the scope of this presentation, it should be added that the first major strike came in 1904, and it was lost largely because of the varieties of division among the workers. It would be 1909 before they struck as a unified class. Perhaps the most significant element in the labour disputes during the first years was the local media's general response, and the attitude it revealed toward the workmen generally.
