Looking back, I know it was wrong. However, I was just so young and inexperi? enced that I couldn't realize that they had other thoughts than mine.... And my aunt and uncle had looked after me all my life. They were very, very good to me. They built a home in Glace Bay. That was for me. although they didn't tell me that it was for me. But I felt that they had done all these things because of me. So, Ida. my Aunt Ida. was my mother's old? er sister. And they were not blessed with children. And when I was about 5 or 6, my mother was expecting my baby sister Patri? cia. And I guess they had their eye on me.
