agreeable when her mother came home from work. They shopped and visited and spent as much time together as they could. Annie and John lived in Boston for four or five years in the third floor apartment on Minot Street in Dorchester. Finally John was notified that his bid for a house on the reserve in Barra Head was approved and was being built, so they packed up all their worldly possessions and headed north in summer of 1974. Marie had graduated with a master's degree in education from Harvard Graduate School of Education and she had decided to move to California with her life partner James Youngblood Henderson who had received an offer to teach at the University of California, Berkeley, after graduating from Harvard Law School. When they returned to Chapel Island, I serve, John and Annie found their house was just a shell, but it did have electricity and plumbing. It served their needs as their home while they worked each day on the house. The reserve sent L.I.P. (Labour Initiative Program) workers from the reserve to their house each day, but since they were just carpenter trades, they lacked skill, initiative or attention to their work. They arrived late each day, ate meals with Annie and John, sat around having tea and watching each other work, and finally left early or did not show up after payday for several days. Finally after several weeks, John began the work himself, doing all the finishing work in his house, and completed the house with his talents and his own funds. The house was finally finished. John and Annie Battiste finally had returned to their "home" again among their family and friends after spending 25 years in the States. Solidified by their love of each other, hardened by their poverty and hard times, softened by children and grandchildren;
