And I think he and the other fellow were drowned. And Severance, I think, he hung onto the boat or something, and eventually somebody got to him, saved him. But they never did find the bodies of the fellows that drowned--Grandfather and.... I think it was his brother-in-law. It was Effie's brother (Murdoch's wife, Effie Ferguson MacDonald)--Grandmother's brother. So it was kind of a double family tragedy there, at that time. So that left Grand? mother with this family of seven, and some of the health problems that were there. I don't know what she died from. But by the time she died, three of the girls had died before her. She died in the early 1900s, not too long after Murdoch was drowned-- only about four years, I think.
